Bicycle Patrol Advanced Tuesday, October 31, 2023

This course will cover the following:

- Advanced bicycle / E-bike riding skills and how to safely integrate those skills with patrol operations.
- Firearms / shooting from a stationary and dis-mounted bicycle.
- Crowd control tactics.

Required: Students must have successfully completed the 40-hour POST Basic Bicycle Patrol Training Course prior to enrolling in this training.

Required Equipment and Attire:

Patrol Bicycle (Standard or E-Bike) helmet, gloves, eye protection, ear protection, and a water bottle/water. Clothing will be "workout" or sports type clothing, which is NOT loose fitting. Loose clothing will catch on to the bicycle components, making it difficult to perform the required movements while on the bicycle. Dress for the weather. If it is raining, we will be riding. If it is cold or hot, we will be riding.

Please bring an extra inner tube for your bicycle, Duty handgun, 50 rounds of ammunition per shooter, 3 handgun magazines, ballistic vest, and duty belt with holster and magazine pouches.

Other gear that you may want to bring: Rain gear, jacket, sunscreen.
