## Basic Police Motorcycle Training

### Course Description:

Provides basic skills for motorcycle traffic patrol duties. Proper riding techniques allowing for the safe operation of a police motorcycle are taught. The course includes riding skills, survival techniques, accident cause and prevention, and motorcycle familiarization. **An M1 License is required to register for the class.**

### Required Equipment:

Police motorcycle that meets all factory specifications. This includes minimum 1000cc Motorcycle with a properly working ABS braking system, proper tire wear, lighting (with or without emergency lighting) and an FPD instructor inspection of the motorcycle. Please Note: Electric Bikes are not allowed as they do not meet the POST Curriculum requirements. **A limited number of rentals are available for \$96.83 per day, on a first come first served basis.**

### Attire:

Blue long-sleeved jumpsuit or BDU type uniform with department shoulder patches, approved boots (soles less than ¾ in), DOT approved motorcycle helmet, leather gloves (thin), shatter-proof eyewear, rain gear (seasonal).
